



# Printable Wear Card

Every vehicle experiences a few bumps along the way, and some wear is considered normal. Knowing what constitutes “excess” over “normal” can help your lease end go smoother. The Lease End Guide and the Wear Card will help you identify what repairs may be needed to avoid excess wear charges.

After printing this card, cut it out and hold it against dents, dings, cracks, chips, stains or tire treads to assess your vehicle’s condition.

## Instructions

1. For best results, print this document using your printer’s “Best Quality” setting. Be sure to disable any scaling or page-fitting options.\* The card should measure 6 3/4 (6.75) inches by 2 1/2 (2.5) inches.
2. Using scissors, carefully trim along the dotted line.
3. Use the ruler along the bottom to measure your vehicle’s wear.
4. To measure tire tread depth, insert the bottom edge of the card into tire tread. If your vehicle’s tire tread meets normal conditions, the tread depth indicator will not be visible.

### Wear Card

- Fewer than 4 dings per panel less than 2"
- 1 dent less than 4" or 1 scratch less than 6" per panel
- Interior cuts and tears smaller than 1/2"
- Wheel scratches and gouges less than 3"
- Removable stains and minor carpet wear
- For most tires, tire tread depth of at least 4/32" from the lowest point. When inserting bottom edge of card into tire tread, the blue color indicator should not be visible. Please see your Lease-End Guide for additional important tire information.

**Normal wear conditions include:**

1"  
Glass cracks & chips  
1/2"  
Interior stains  
2"  
Dings under 2" (fewer than 4 per panel)
